A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 304A-402, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

2 amended to read as follows:

3 "[+] \$304A-402[+] Residence for tuition purposes; basic

4 rule[+]; exception for military. (a) The board of regents

5 shall adopt the necessary rules defining residence for tuition

6 purposes [herein]; provided that the basic rule shall be that a

student shall qualify for the resident tuition fee only if the

following criteria are met:

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- (1) The adult student, or in the case of a minor student, the student's parents or guardians, has or have been a bona fide resident of this State for at least twelve consecutive months next preceding the student's first day of officially scheduled instruction for any semester or term in which the student is enrolling at
- (2) The adult or minor student has not been claimed as a dependent for tax purposes for at least twelve months next preceding the student's first day of officially

the particular college or campus; and

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1	scheduled instruction for any semester or term in		
2	which the student is enrolling at the particular		
3	college or campus by the student's parents or		
4	guardians who are nonresidents of the State; provided		
5	that this provision shall not apply in cases where the		
6	parent claiming the student as a dependent is entitled		
7	to do so under a child support order or agreement		
8	issued or entered into in conjunction with a divorce		
9	proceeding or legal separation agreement and the other		
10	parent and the student meet the criteria set forth in		
11	paragraph (1).		
12	(b) A student shall also qualify for the resident tuition		
13	fee if the student is a member of the armed forces on active		
14	duty for a period of more than thirty days whose permanent duty		
15	station is in the State, or the dependent of such a member. The		
16	resident tuition fee shall continue to apply to such a student;		
17	provided that the student is continuously enrolled at the		
18	university, and shall not be discontinued solely because of a		
19	subsequent change in the permanent duty station of the member to		
20	a location outside of the State.		
21	For the purposes of this subsection, "permanent duty		
22	station" shall mean the member's domicile or homeport."		

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1 SECTION 2. Section 304A-502, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows: 2 3 "[+] \$304A-502[+] Power of regents to grant tuition 4 The board of regents, or its designated 5 representatives, is authorized to grant, modify, or suspend 6 tuition waivers. 7 The board may: 8 (1) Waive entirely or reduce the tuition fee or any of the 9 other fees for graduate teaching and research 10 assistants; 11 (2) Enter into agreements with government and university 12 officials of any other state or foreign country to provide for reciprocal waiver of the nonresident 13 tuition and fee differential; 14 (3) Waive the nonresident tuition and fee differential for 15 16 selected students from Pacific and Asian jurisdictions 17 when their presence would be beneficial to the university or the State; 18 19 (4)Waive entirely or reduce the tuition fee or any of the 20 other fees for students, resident or nonresident; and 21 Waive the nonresident tuition and fee differential for (5) 22 members in good standing of the following military

3	(A)	The Hawaii national guard; [and]	
4	(B)	The federal reserve components of the Army, Navy

8	(C)	Members of the armed forces on active duty for a	
9		period of more than thirty days whose permanent	
10		duty station is in the State. The waiver of the	
11		nonresident tuition and fee differential shall	
12		continue to apply to the student, provided that	
13		the student is continuously enrolled at the	
14		university, and shall not be discontinued solely	
15		because of a subsequent change in the permanent	
16		duty station of the member to a location outside	
17		of the State.	
18	The board shall	l determine the percentage of allowable tuition	
19	and fee waivers	s for financial need and other university	
20	priorities. These tuition waivers and waivers of the		
21	nonresident tuition and fee differential shall be awarded in		
22	accordance with	n guidelines established by the board."
