A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRAFFIC SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§286- Traffic schools; certification. (a) The
- 5 director shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91 for the
- 6 certification of traffic schools for traffic offenders that
- 7 address facilities, equipment, courses of instruction,
- 8 instructors, fees, and records of the program. Schools
- 9 certified by the director pursuant to this section and the rules
- 10 adopted under it shall be composed of uniform education and
- 11 training elements designed to create a correcting and lasting
- 12 effect on traffic offenders. In lieu of assessing penalties for
- 13 traffic offenses, the court may allow offenders to attend
- 14 traffic school, pursuant to section 291C- .
- 15 (b) A person who attends the state traffic school as
- 16 provided in this section shall pay a fee, to be established by

1	the direc	tor pursuant to subsection (a), to defray the cost of
2	operating the school."	
3	SECTION 2. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
4	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated	
5	and to read as follows:	
6	" <u>§29</u>	1C- Diversion program. (a) A district court shall
7	allow the	continuance of a proceeding against any person who
8	receives	a summons or citation for a moving violation pursuant
9	to this c	hapter, in consideration of attendance at a traffic
10	school fo	r traffic violators certified pursuant to section 286-
11	within	the time prescribed by the court; provided that:
12	(1)	The offense is not alleged to have been committed
13		within twenty-four months of another offense that was
14		dismissed under this section;
15	(2)	The offense did not result in death or serious
16		physical injury;
17	(3)	At the time of the offense, the person was not driving
18		while under the influence of an intoxicant; and
19	(4)	At the time of the offense, the person possessed a
20		valid driver's license that had not been suspended or
21		revoked.

1	(b) Upon certification of completion of the traffic school		
2	course for a traffic offender, the court shall dismiss the		
3	complaint and order that the record of the moving violation be		
4	deleted from the person's driving record kept pursuant to		
5	section 286-137.		
6	(c) A person who attends a traffic school pursuant to this		
7	section shall be assessed a diversion fee in an amount that		
8	shall be determined by the supreme court. Payment of the		
9	diversion fee shall be accepted in lieu of payment of a civil		
10	penalty or criminal fine that is imposed for a traffic		
11	violation."		
12	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.		
13	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Report Title:

Traffic Code; Traffic School Diversion Program

Description:

Requires the director of transportation to certify traffic schools for traffic offenders. Allows certain violators who receive a citation for a moving violation to attend a traffic school, have the case dismissed, and have the record of the moving violation deleted from the person's driving record.
