## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO METAL.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 445-233, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended as follows: 3 1. By amending subsection (b) to read: 4 If the scrap presented for purchase is copper, in 5 whole or in part, or a beer keg, the seller shall provide a copy 6 of a receipt that describes, with particularity: 7 The exact item that is being offered for sale; (1)8 Who issued the receipt; (2)The date of sale of the item prior to the item's being 9 (3) 10 offered to the scrap dealer; and 11 (4)The price, if any, of the item when obtained by the 12 seller." 13 By amending subsections (d) through (f) to read: 14 "(d) If the seller does not provide a copy of the receipt 15 or the notarized declaration as required by subsections (b) and

(c), the scrap dealer shall not purchase the copper, in whole or

- 1 in part, or beer keg and shall report the attempted sale to the
- 2 police.
- 3 (e) If the scrap dealer purchases any copper, in whole or
- 4 in part, or a beer keg, the scrap dealer shall take a photograph
- 5 or photographs of all of the copper offered for sale.
- 6 (f) The scrap dealer shall also require the seller to
- 7 verify the seller's identity by presenting a valid photo
- 8 identification card or license issued by a federal or state
- 9 government agency authorized to issue such identification. If
- 10 the scrap being offered for sale is copper, in whole or in part,
- 11 or a beer keg, the scrap dealer shall:
- 12 (1) Take a photograph of the seller; or
- (2) Make a photocopy of the identification card or license
- of the seller."
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 708-835.7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- "[ $\{ \}$  §708-835.7[ $\}$ ] Theft of copper[ $\{ \}$ ] or beer keg. (1) A
- 18 person commits the offense of theft of copper or beer keg if the
- 19 person commits theft of copper that weighs a pound or more, but
- 20 not including legal tender of the United States[-], or of a beer
- 21 keg.
- 22 (2) Theft of copper or a beer keg is a class C felony."

- 2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 3 begun, before its effective date.
- 4 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
