BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	that the home environment is safe and to prevent the		
2	abandonment of children, and keep families intact

5	In addition to state funding of the [pilot] perinatal		
6	clinic, funding for perinatal and pediatric services of the		
7	clinic shall be pursued through the state medicaid program.		
8	[(b) The pilot perinatal clinic shall cease operations on		
9	June 30, 2009.]"		
10	SECTION 2. Act 248, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006, as		
11	amended by Act 147, Session Laws of Hawaii 2007, is amended by		
12	amending section 3 to read as follows:		
13	"SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general		
14	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of [\$200,000] \$100,000		
15	or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year [2007-		
16	2008, 2008-2009 to [establish] continue operations and services		
17	as needed, including case management services, for a [pilot]		
18	perinatal clinic [and provide case management services].		
19	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of		
20	human services for the purposes of this Act."		
21	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed		
22	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
