## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREARMS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 134-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending the definition of "firearm" to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 "Firearm" means any weapon, for which the operating force
- 5 is an explosive, including but not limited to pistols,
- 6 revolvers, rifles, shotguns, automatic firearms, noxious gas
- 7 projectors, mortars, bombs, and cannon[.], except that the term
- 8 shall also include electric quns."
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 134-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 10 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
- "(c) Any person who violates section 134-2, 134-4, 134-10,
- 12 or 134-15[ or 134-16(a)] shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. Any
- 13 person who violates section 134-3(b) shall be guilty of a petty
- 14 misdemeanor and the firearm shall be confiscated as contraband
- 15 and disposed of, if the firearm is not registered within five
- 16 days of the person receiving notice of the violation."

         [#§134-16 Restriction on possession, sale, gift, or

    delivery of electric guns. (a) It shall be unlawful for any

    person, including a licensed manufacturer, licensed importer, or

    licensed dealer, to possess, offer for sale, hold for sale,

    sell, give, lend, or deliver any electric gun.

         (b) Any electric gun in violation of subsection (a) shall

    be confiscated and disposed of by the chief of police.

         (c) This section shall not apply to law enforcement

    officers of county police and sheriff departments of this State,

    or vendors providing electric guns to those entities; provided

    that electric guns shall at all times remain in the custody and

    control of the county police or sheriff departments.

         (d) The county police and sheriff departments of this

    State shall maintain records regarding every electric gun in
