RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

8	286-26[ <del></del>	shall be fined not more than \$100].
9	(b)	Any person who violates this section shall be subject

11	(1)	A fine of not less than \$500 and not more than \$1,000
12		for the first violation;
13	(2)	A fine of not less than \$750 and not more than \$1,000
14		for the second violation; and
15	<u>(3)</u>	A fine of not less than \$1,000 and suspension of
16		license and privileges to operate a vehicle for a
17		period of thirty days for a third or subsequent
