A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The judiciary may establish a three-year
- 2 statewide family court pilot project for the electronic filing
- 3 of temporary restraining orders and the issuance of temporary
- 4 restraining orders on nights and weekends, when the courts are
- 5 closed.
- 6 In establishing the pilot project, the judiciary may
- 7 examine the electronic temporary restraining order program
- 8 initiated by New Jersey, known as "E-TRO".
- 9 The judiciary may also consider allowing electronic
- 10 signatures of family court judges and complainants on nights and
- 11 weekends and allowing complaints to appear immediately on the
- 12 judiciary's website for service and enforcement.
- 13 The police departments in each county and the prosecuting
- 14 attorneys in each county shall cooperate with the judiciary to
- 15 develop and implement the components of the pilot project.
- 16 The judiciary may submit to the legislature interim reports
- 17 of the pilot project, no later than twenty days prior to the

- 1 convening of the regular sessions of 2009 and 2010, and a final
- 2 report, no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the
- 3 regular session of 2011, that include information and
- 4 recommendations about the efficacy of, and costs associated
- 5 with, the electronic temporary restraining order pilot project,
- 6 including whether the electronic temporary restraining order
- 7 pilot project should be made permanent.
- 8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for a
- 11 family court electronic temporary restraining order pilot
- 12 project to be established by the judiciary.
- 13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
- 14 the purposes of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2080.
