A BILL FOR AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

By amending subsections (d) and (e) of section 2 to 9 read: 10 "(d) Not less than twenty days prior to the convening of 11 the regular sessions of 2007 [and], 2008, and 2009, the task 12 force shall provide to the legislature a report on its 13 activities[-]; provided that not less than twenty days prior to 14 the convening of the regular session of 2010, the task force shall provide the legislature a final report of its activities, 15 16 including findings and recommendations, and any proposed 17 legislation. (e) The task force shall cease to exist on June 30, 18 [2008.] 2010." 19 20 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
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revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$

- 2 and clerical expenses of the Hawaii anti-trafficking task force.
- 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 4 the attorney general for the purposes of this Act.

- 6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008;
- 8 provided that section 1 shall take effect on June 29, 2008.
