RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 103D-206, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "\$103D-206 Additional duties of the administrator of the procurement office. In addition to the duties referred to in 4 5 section 103D-205, the administrator shall: 6 (1)Perform periodic review of the procurement practices 7 of all governmental bodies; 8 Assist, advise, and guide governmental bodies in (2) 9 matters relating to procurement[+], including 10 determinations of corrective actions; provided that if 11 a governmental body fails to comply with any 12 determination rendered by the administrator within 13 thirty days, the governmental body shall be subject to 14 an administrative fine under section 103D-106, for 15 every day of noncompliance; 16 Develop and administer a statewide procurement (3) 17 orientation and training program;

- 1 (4)Develop, distribute, and maintain a procurement manual for all state procurement officials; and
- Develop, distribute, and maintain a procurement guide 3 (5) for vendors wishing to do business with the State and 5 its counties."
- 6 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
