## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TAXATION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to allow an
- 2 individual taxpayer who files an electronic income tax return to
- 3 request that the department of taxation deposit electronically
- 4 the taxpayer's income tax refund into a maximum of three
- 5 checking or savings accounts.
- 6 SECTION 2. Chapter 235, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 7 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 8 and to read as follows:
- 9 "§235- Refund splitting. The department of taxation
- 10 shall revise returns required to be filed pursuant to this
- 11 chapter to allow an individual taxpayer who files an income tax
- 12 return electronically to designate up to a maximum of three
- 13 checking or savings accounts at financial institutions for
- 14 direct deposit of the taxpayer's income tax refund."
- 15 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 16 SECTION 4. This Act, upon its approval, shall apply to
- 17 taxable years beginning after December 31, 2007.
