A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ECONOMIC DIVERSIFICATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that economic development
- 2 in Hawaii is a prime concern in the face on an increasingly weak
- 3 national economy. Currently, there is a broad range of
- 4 organizations both public and private working to create
- 5 economic opportunities. The private nonprofit economic
- 6 development boards of the four counties, and their umbrella
- 7 organization, the Economic Development Alliance of Hawaii, offer
- 8 a wide variety of services to recruit, nurture, and build the
- 9 State's diverse private sector businesses. Organizations such
- 10 the Hawaii Science and Technology Council focus on the needs of
- 11 the growing technology industry and the Hawaii Technology
- 12 Development Venture, through federal funding, provides support
- 13 to Hawaii's dual use sector.
- 14 The legislature further finds that using the expertise of
- 15 these and other economic development organizations through a
- 16 unified approach would provide opportunities to expand the STEM

- 1 academies and the creative media initiatives currently funded by
- 2 legislature.
- 3 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys for
- 4 economic diversification activities.
- 5 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for
- 8 economic diversification activities.
- 9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 10 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of
- 11 this Act.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
