RELATING TO THE HAWAII PUBLIC PROCUREMENT CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 103D-302, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (h) to read as follows: 3 "(h) The contract shall be awarded with reasonable promptness by written notice to the lowest responsible and 4 5 responsive bidder whose bid meets the requirements and criteria 6 set forth in the invitation for bids. Any false information or misrepresentation knowingly placed in the bid shall be a basis 7 8 for not awarding the bid to that bidder. Additionally, the chief procurement officer shall place the bidder on a one year 9 10 mandatory suspension from bidding for any contract under this 11 chapter, if, after affording the bidder a reasonable opportunity to be heard, the chief procurement officer finds that the bidder 12 knowingly placed false information or any misrepresentation in a 13 14 In the event all bids exceed available funds as certified bid. 15 by the appropriate fiscal officer, the head of the purchasing 16 agency responsible for the procurement in question is authorized 17 in situations where time or economic considerations preclude 2008-0822 SB SMA-1.doc
