A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ARCHAEOLOGICAL DATA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 6E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2	by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3	read as follows:
4	" <u>§6E-</u> Archaeological data survey; designation. (a)
5	There is established a Hawaii archaeological data survey
6	designated as a program of the State of Hawaii Museum of Natural
7	and Cultural History. The survey shall be an online database of
8	archaeological documents and materials, including but not
9	limited to reports, photographs, drawings, maps, and archived
10	documents obtained through archaeological work in Hawaii, and
11	may include the collections of the Bernice Pauahi Bishop Museum,
12	publicly available materials, and materials from private
13	entities or organizations. To expand the use and knowledge of
14	Hawaii's archaeological information, the data survey shall be
15	developed and maintained in consultation with the state historic
16	preservation division and other appropriate state and federal

17 agencies and private organizations.

1	(b) The archaeological data survey shall not include any
2	information required to remain confidential under federal,
3	state, or municipal laws, rules, or regulations.
4	(c) The State of Hawaii Museum of Natural and Cultural
5	History, in consultation with the office of Hawaiian affairs and
6	the state historic preservation division, may temporarily or
7	permanently withhold from the database any information due to a
8	valid threat, or if disclosure may frustrate the legitimate and
9	necessary function of protecting a valuable archaeological site
10	or artifact. The entities shall determine what information
11	shall be withheld from the data survey; provided that prior
12	consultation is sought with any affected state or federal
13	governmental agencies, or private individuals or organizations."
14	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
15	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
