A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC ORDER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 711-1100, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending the definition of "pet animal" to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 ""Pet animal" means a dog, cat, domesticated rabbit, quinea
- 5 pig, domesticated pig, [or] caged [birds] bird (passeriformes,
- 6 piciformes, and psittaciformes only), or horse so long as not
- 7 bred for consumption."
- 8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
