A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC ORDER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 711-1108.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "[+]\$711-1108.5[+] Cruelty to animals in the first degree. 4 A person commits the offense of cruelty to animals in the 5 first degree if the person intentionally or knowingly tortures, mutilates, or poisons or causes the torture, mutilation, or 6 poisoning of any pet animal or equine animal resulting in 7 8 serious bodily injury or death of the pet animal[-] or equine 9 animal.
- 10 Subsection (1) shall not apply to: (2)
- 11 Accepted veterinary practices: (a)
- 12 (b) Activities carried on for scientific research governed 13 by standards of accepted educational or medicinal 14 practices; or
- 15 (c) Cropping or docking as customarily practiced.
- 16 (3) Whenever any pet animal is so severely injured that 17 there is no reasonable probability that its life can be saved,

- 1 the pet animal may be immediately destroyed without creating any
- 2 offense under this section.
- 3 (4) Cruelty to animals in the first degree is a class C
- 4 felony."
- 5 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
