A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VETERANS CEMETERIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that funds allotted in the
- 2 state budget for repairs and improvement work at veterans
- 3 cemeteries in fiscal years 2008 and 2009 were intended to be
- 4 used statewide. However, the office of veterans services
- 5 intends to expend the majority of the appropriated funds on
- 6 improvements to the veterans cemetery located in Kaneohe, Oahu.
- 7 This action does not serve the legislature's intent.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to clarify the requirements for
- 9 the use of funding allotted in the state budget for repair and
- 10 importance to veterans cemeteries. Specifically, it serves to
- 11 allot funds between the counties, ensuring statewide
- 12 distribution of the funds.
- 13 SECTION 2. Act 213, Session Laws of Hawaii 2007, is
- 14 amended by adding a new section to part V to be appropriately
- 15 designated and to read as follows:
- 16 "SECTION . Provided that of the general obligation bond
- 17 fund appropriation for services to veterans (DEF 112), item F-6,
