8	capital p	rojects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
9	designate	d expending agency for the purposes of this Act as
10	follows:	
11	(1)	For items 1 and 18 the expending agency shall be the
12		county of Kauai;
13	(2)	For item 2 the expending agency shall be the
14		department of defense;
15	(3)	For item 3 the expending agency shall be the Hawaii
16		health systems corporation;
17	(4)	For items 4, 5, 6, 20 and 21 the expending agency
18		shall be the department of education;
19	(5)	For items 7, 8, 9, 15 and 19 the expending agency
