BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The lack of affordable housing in Hawaii is one 2 of the major concerns for the people in Hawaii who do not own a To aid in resolving that concern, a fund to grant the 3 department of Hawaiian home lands to gather industry experts and 4 5 community leaders to identify key strategies and approaches to 6 expanding the production of affordable housing units, including 7 self-help, multi-family, and single family units, that are owned 8 and operated by nonprofit developers and community organizations 9 The pilot project would initially be started on 10 Hawaiian homestead lands. 11 In order to create sustainable economic development 12 projects, a pilot nonprofit developer consultation project 13 program needs to be established to examine and produce 14 recommendations to increase the participation of community based 15 organizations in development projects. - 6 and also furthers the goals of the department of Hawaiian home

- 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 13 much thereof as may be necessary for the fiscal year 2008-2009
- 14 for the pilot nonprofit developer consultation project program
- 15 of the department of Hawaiian home lands.
- 16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 17 Hawaiian home lands for the purposes of this Act.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
