## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENERGY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 269-91, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending the definition of "renewable electrical energy" to read as follows: 3 4 "[PART V. RENEWABLE PORTFOLIO STANDARDS] 5 §269-91 [Definitions.] For the purposes of this [part]: "Biofuels" means liquid or gaseous fuels produced from 6 organic sources such as biomass crops, agricultural residues and 7 8 oil crops, such as palm oil, canola oil, soybean oil, waste 9 cooking oil, grease, and food wastes, animal residues and 10 wastes, and sewage and landfill wastes. 11 "Cost-effective" means the ability to produce or purchase 12 electric energy or firm capacity, or both, from renewable energy 13 resources at or below avoided costs consistent with the 14 methodology set by the public utilities commission in accordance 15 with section 269-27.2.

10		conditioning district cooling systems, solar air
11		conditioning, and customer sited, grid-connected
12		renewable energy systems; or
13	[ <del>[(3)]</del> ]	(2) Electrical energy savings brought about by the
14		use of energy efficiency technologies, including heat
15		pump water heating, ice storage, ratepayer- funded
16		energy efficiency programs, and use of rejected heat
17		from co-generation and combined heat and power
18		systems, excluding fossil-fueled qualifying facilities
19		that sell electricity to electric utility companies
20		and central station power projects.
