BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

Section 84-11.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 "(a) Every legislator and employee shall file a gifts disclosure statement with the state ethics commission on June 30 4 of each year if all the following conditions are met: 5 6 (1) The legislator or employee, or spouse or dependent child of a legislator or employee, received directly or indirectly from one source any gift or gifts valued 8 9 singly or in the aggregate in excess of [\$200,] \$100, 10 whether the gift is in the form of money, service, 11 goods, or in any other form; 12 The source of the gift or gifts have interests that (2) may be affected by official action or lack of action 13 14 by the legislator or employee; and 15 The gift is not exempted by subsection (d) from (3) 16 reporting requirements under this [subsection.]
