- 3 upon checks issued by the comptroller; provided departments must
- 4 obtain the approval of the attorney general before payment of
- 5 any claim can be made.
- 6 SECTION 4. Notwithstanding the sums hereinabove stated as
- 7 interest upon judgments against the State, payment of interest
- 8 shall be limited to the period from the date of judgment, if
- 9 applicable, to thirty days after the effective date of this
- 10 part, as provided in section 662-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for
- 11 those cases to which the statute applies.
- 12 PART III
- 13 SECTION 5. All unexpended and unencumbered balances of the
- 14 appropriations made in this Act as of the close of business on
- 15 June 30, 2009, shall lapse.
- 16 SECTION 6. If any provision of this Act, or the
- 17 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held
- 18 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
- 19 applications of the Act, which can be given effect without the
- 20 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
- 21 of this Act are severable.
- 22 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
