## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO APPELLATE JURISDICTION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to authorize
2	immediate appeals from certain orders regarding injunctions and
3	from denials of sovereign or qualified immunity, assuming such
4	appeals were not already authorized or allowed.
5	SECTION 2. Section 641-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	"§641-1 Appeals as of right or interlocutory, civil
8	matters. (a) Appeals shall be allowed in civil matters from
9	all final judgments, orders, or decrees of circuit and district
10	courts and the land court to the intermediate appellate court,
11	subject to chapter 602.
12	(b) [Upon application made within the time provided by the
13	rules of court, Except for interlocutory appeals as a matter of
14	right as provided in subsection (c), an appeal in a civil matter
15	may be allowed by a circuit court in its discretion from an
16	order denying a motion to dismiss or from any interlocutory
17	judgment, order, or decree whenever the circuit court may think

the same advisable for the speedy termination of litigation

- 1 before it. The refusal of the circuit court to allow an appeal
- 2 from an interlocutory judgment, order, or decree shall not be
- 3 reviewable by any other court.
- 4 (c) Appeals shall be allowed from interlocutory orders of
- 5 the circuit courts, the land court, and the district courts,
- 6 that deny motions seeking dismissal, or judgment for the movant,
- 7 based upon sovereign immunity or qualified immunity.
- 8 [<del>(e)</del>] (d) An application to the circuit court to permit an
- 9 interlocutory appeal under subsection (b) and any appeal shall
- 10 be taken in the manner and within the time provided by the rules
- 11 of court."
- 12 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2099 and
- 15 shall apply fully to all cases filed on or after its effective
- 16 date and all cases pending in the circuit and district courts
- 17 and the land court for which no final judgment has been entered
- 18 as of its effective date, to the extent permitted by law;
- 19 provided that the amendments made to section 641-1, Hawaii
- 20 Revised Statutes, by this Act shall not be repealed if wording
- 21 in section 641-1 in effect on June 30, 2006, is reenacted
- 22 pursuant to Act 202, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, as amended by

- 1 Act 94, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006, and any other act, unless
- 2 the amendments made by this Act are expressly amended or
- 3 repealed in that other act.
