A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ADULT PROTECTIVE SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 346-222, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted 3 and to read as follows: 4 ""Caregiver" means any person who has undertaken the care, 5 custody, or physical control of, or who has a legal or 6 contractual duty to care for the health, safety, and welfare of 7 a dependent adult." 8 SECTION 2. Section 346-224, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 9 amended to read as follows: 10 "[{]\$346-224[}] Reports. (a) The following persons who, 11 in the performance of their professional or official duties, 12 know or have reason to believe that a dependent adult has been 13 abused and is threatened with imminent abuse shall promptly 14 report the matter orally to the department of human services to
- 15 the maximum extent permitted by federal law:
 16 (1) Any licensed or registered professional of the healing
 17 arts and any health-related occupation who examines,
- treats, or provides other professional or specialized

2		limited to, physicians, physicians in training,
3		psychologists, dentists, nurses, osteopathic
4		physicians and surgeons, optometrists, chiropractors,
5		podiatrists, pharmacists, and other health-related
6		professionals;
7	(2)	Employees or officers of any public or private agency
8		or institution providing social, medical, hospital or
9		mental health services, including financial
10		assistance;
11	(3)	Employees or officers of any law enforcement agency
12		including, but not limited to, the courts, police
13		departments, correctional institutions, and parole or
14		probation offices;
15	(4)	Employees or officers of any adult residential care
16		home, adult day care center, or similar institution;

18	(5)	Medical examiners or coroners[-];
19	<u>(6)</u>	Employees or officers of the entity or agency
20		designated by the governor pursuant to section 333F-
21		8.5 to provide advocacy services to persons with
22		developmental disabilities and mental illness in order

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to receive federal funds authorized by 42 U.S.C.
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              sections 10801 and 15001; and
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         (7) Social workers.

              In addition to the persons enumerated in subsection
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    (a), persons meeting the definition of a "caregiver", as defined
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    in section 346-222, who know or have reason to believe that a
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    dependent adult has been abused and is threatened with imminent
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    abuse shall promptly report the matter orally to the department.
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         [<del>(b)</del>] (c) The initial oral report required by subsection
    (a) shall be followed as soon as possible by a written report to
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    the department; provided that where a police department is the
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    initiating agency, a written report shall not be required unless
    the police department has declined to take further action and
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    the department informs the police department that it intends to
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    pursue the matter of the orally reported incident of abuse. All
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    written reports shall contain the name and address of the
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    dependent adult and the person who or care organization or care
    facility which is alleged to have committed or been responsible
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    for the dependent adult abuse, if known; the nature and extent
    of the dependent adult's injury or harm; and any other
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    information the reporter believes might be helpful in
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    establishing the cause of the dependent adult abuse.
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- 1 [(c)] <u>(d)</u> This section shall not prohibit any of the
- 2 persons enumerated in subsection (a) from reporting incidents
- 3 which those persons have reason to believe involve abuse which
- 4 came to their attention in any private or nonprofessional
- 5 capacity.
- 6 [$\frac{d}{d}$] (e) Any other person who has reason to believe that
- 7 a dependent adult has been abused or is threatened with imminent
- 8 abuse may report the matter orally to the department.
- 9 [(e)] (f) Any person who knowingly fails to report as
- 10 required by this section or who wilfully prevents another person
- 11 from reporting pursuant to this section shall be guilty of a
- 12 petty misdemeanor.
- 13 $\left[\frac{f}{f}\right]$ (g) The department shall maintain a central registry
- 14 of reported cases."
- 15 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
