# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CORRECTIONAL PROGRAM REVOLVING FUND.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 353-33, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 repealed. "[[\$353-33] Correctional program revolving fund; program 3 fees. (a) There is established within the state treasury the correctional program revolving fund. This fund shall be expended 5 at the discretion of the director for the purpose of offsetting 6 the cost of providing programs for inmates. (b) The revolving fund shall consist of funds derived from 8 fees collected pursuant to subsection (c). 9 (c) The director may charge any committed or detained 10 11 person a fee for participation in a correctional program; provided that no person shall be denied access to a program 12 because of the person's inability to pay the fee. The fee shall 13 be reasonably related to the actual cost of providing the 14 program, except that the fee may be reduced, in whole or in part, 15 at the discretion of the director if the director finds that the 16 person is unable to pay the entire fee. ### SB. NO. 3109

DEPARTMENT:

PUBLIC SAFETY

TITLE:

A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE CORRECTIONAL PROGRAM REVOLVING FUND.

PURPOSE:

To delete the correctional program revolving fund because the fund has no funds in it and the department has not used the fund for

several years.

MEANS:

Repeal section 353-33, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

JUSTIFICATION:

The Department of Public Safety has not utilized the correctional program revolving fund for several years, and there are no funds within the fund at this time. This is a revolving fund that requires auditing and reports but serves no practical purpose.

Impact on the public: There should be no impact on the public as this measure will simply delete a revolving fund that has not been used for years and will not impact the public.

Impact on the department and other agencies: This bill should assist both the Department of Public Safety and state auditors as the bill deletes a revolving fund that currently needs to be reviewed and audited but has no realistic function at this time.
