A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CORRECTIONAL PROGRAM REVOLVING FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 353-33, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 repealed. 3 ["[\$353-33] Correctional program revolving fund, program 4 fees. (a) There is established within the state treasury the 5 correctional program revolving fund. This fund shall be 6 expended at the discretion of the director for the purpose of 7 offsetting the cost of providing programs for inmates. 8 (b) The revolving fund shall consist of funds derived from 9 fees collected pursuant to subsection (c). 10 (c) The director may charge any committed or detained 11 person a fee for participation in a correctional program; 12 provided that no person shall be denied access to a program because of the person's inability to pay the fee. The fee shall 13 14 be reasonably related to the actual cost of providing the 15 program, except that the fee may be reduced, in whole or in 16 part, at the discretion of the director if the director finds 17 that the person is unable to pay the entire fee. All fees

1	collected pursuant to this subsection shall be deposited in the
2	correctional program revolving fund.
3	(d) The director shall submit an annual report on the
4	status of the correctional program revolving fund to the
5	legislature at least twenty days prior to the convening of each
6	regular session of the legislature. The report shall include
7	but not be limited to the following:
8	(1) The amount of moneys received and deposited in the
9	correctional program revolving fund for the fiscal
10	year just ended; and
11	(2) Descriptions and amounts of expenditures made from the
12	fund, and the balances remaining on June 30 of each
13	year.
14	The director may include the aforementioned report in its
15	annual report to the legislature and the governor."]
16	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
17	and stricken.
18	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
