A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES FOR AKULE FISH MONITORING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that to understand akule
- 2 fish activity, there is a need to collect and interpret data
- 3 about akule fish movements and habits of migration from Pearl
- 4 Harbor to Ka'ena Point, Oahu.
- 5 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$25,000 or so much
- 7 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for the
- 8 department of land and natural resources, in conjunction with
- 9 the Hawaii institute of marine biology, to hire a contractor to
- 10 tag and monitor akule fish along the leeward coast of Oahu from
- 11 Pearl Harbor to Kaena Point.
- 12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 13 land and natural resources, in conjunction with the Hawaii
- 14 institute of marine biology, for the purposes of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
