A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIMES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 711, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated

 and to read as follows:

 "S711- Human consumption of a cat, dog, or horse. (1)

 Unless otherwise authorized by law, a person commits the offense
- 6 of human consumption of a cat, dog, or horse, if the person
- 7 <u>intentionally or knowingly consumes a cat, dog, or horse.</u>
- 8 (2) Nothing in this section is intended to affect any
- 9 <u>civil remedies available for a violation of this section.</u>
- 10 (3) The human consumption of a cat, dog, or horse is a
- 11 <u>misdemeanor.</u>"
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 711-1100, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended by amending the definition of "pet animal" to read as
- 14 follows:
- ""Pet animal" means a dog, cat, horse, domesticated rabbit,
- 16 guinea pig, domesticated pig, or caged [birds] bird
- 17 (passeriformes, piciformes, and psittaciformes only) [so long

- 1 as]; provided that the domesticated rabbit, guinea pig,
- 2 domesticated pig, or caged bird is not bred for consumption."
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun, before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
