A BILL FOR AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

(a) Except as provided in sections 603-21.5 and 604-8, the court shall have exclusive 4 5 original jurisdiction: 6 [(1) To try any offense committed against a child by the 7 child's parent or guardian or by any other person having the child's legal or physical custody, and any 8 violation of section 707-726, 707-727, 709-902, 709-9 903, 709-903.5, 709-904, 709-905, 709-906, or 302A-10 11 1135, whether or not included in other provisions of 12 this paragraph or paragraph (2); (2) (1) To try any adult charged with: 13 14 Deserting, abandoning, or failing to provide (A) support for any person in violation of law; or 15 16 (B) An offense, other than a felony, against the 17 person of the defendant's husband or wife;
