A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. In 2013, the National Museum of the United
- 2 States Army will open in the heart of the national capitol
- 3 region. The National Museum of the United States Army is a
- 4 long-overdue tribute to the service and sacrifice of soldiers
- 5 from colonial times to the present. The museum will preserve
- 6 the rich history of the Army and provide a million visitors
- 7 annually with an appreciation of the Army's contributions to the
- 8 nation.
- 9 For the past two hundred thirty-one years, the Army has
- 10 protected the United States and its citizens from all enemies,
- 11 domestic and foreign. Soldiers in colonial times to the present
- 12 have ensured the freedoms and protected the liberties enjoyed
- 13 today by every person living in the United States. Courage,
- 14 commitment, service, and sacrifice have been the hallmarks of
- 15 those who served in the Army's ranks. The Army has never had a
- 16 national museum to focus on the history and heritage of the
- 17 American soldier.

- 1 Hawaii's veterans are a major segment of the history of the
- 2 United States Army. The 100th Battalion and the 442nd Infantry
- 3 Division in World War II, the soldiers who served in the Korean
- 4 and Vietnam wars, and the troops from Schofield Barracks who are
- 5 currently deployed to the Middle East, are tributes to Hawaii's
- 6 heroic tradition of military service.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation for the
- 8 design, construction, and exhibits of the National Museum of the
- 9 United States Army.
- 10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, which
- 12 is equivalent to \$1 for every United States army veteran living
- 13 in Hawaii on the effective date of this Act, or so much thereof
- 14 as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for the design,
- 15 construction, and exhibits of the National Museum of the United
- 16 States Army.
- 17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 18 defense for the purposes of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
