#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE TWENTY-FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue general obligation bonds in the sum of \$50,420,220, or so much 2 3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much 4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year 2008-2009, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for 5 the twenty-first senatorial district, as follows: 6 7 Hale Ola Ho'o Pa'kolea 8 Demolition of existing structure 9 and construction of a new 10 community center. 11 Total funding \$175,000 12 2.
