## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DISABLED PERSONS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The Hawaii Revised Statutes section 347-20
- 2 states that "...it is the policy of this State to encourage and
- 3 enable the . . . physically disabled to participate fully in the
- 4 social and economic life of the State...". As such, the purpose
- 5 of this Act is to enable disabled persons who display windshield
- 6 placards obtained under chapter 291, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to
- 7 use high occupancy vehicle lanes without regard to the number of
- 8 vehicle occupants.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 291C-222, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- "§291C-222 Designation of high occupancy vehicle lane.
- 12 (a) The director of transportation by rules adopted in
- 13 accordance with chapter 91, and the counties by ordinance, may
- 14 designate high occupancy vehicle lanes as to roadways under
- 15 their respective jurisdictions.
- 16 (b) Signs and other official traffic-control devices that
- 17 designate high occupancy vehicle lanes shall be placed and

- 1 maintained to advise drivers of the high occupancy vehicle
- 2 requirement and the hours of usage. When the high occupancy
- 3 vehicle lane also serves as a contraflow lane, the hours of
- 4 usage as a high occupancy vehicle lane shall be the time when
- 5 the lane is coned for use as a high occupancy vehicle lane.
- 6 (c) No motor vehicle shall be operated upon these lanes
- 7 except in conformance with the instructions on the signs and
- 8 other official traffic-control devices.
- 9 (d) A disabled person who properly displays an unexpired
- 10 windshield placard obtained in accordance with chapter 291,
- 11 part III, may use any high occupancy vehicle lane, regardless of
- 12 the number of occupants in the person's vehicle.
- 13 [-(d)] (e) A motorcycle may use any high occupancy vehicle
- 14 lane, regardless of the number of occupants.
- 15 [<del>(e)</del>] (f) Any vehicle authorized by rules adopted in
- 16 accordance with chapter 91 may use any high occupancy vehicle
- 17 lane, regardless of the number of occupants, when the use is
- 18 determined to enhance public safety and improves traffic
- 19 conditions."
- 20 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 21 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
