RELATING TO ANIMAL HOARDING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	TION 1. Chapter 711, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:	
4	" <u>§7</u> 1	.1- Animal hoarding. (1) A person commits the
5	offense o	f animal hoarding if the person:
6	<u>(a)</u>	Negligently possesses more than a typical number of
7		<pre>pet animals;</pre>
8	<u>(b)</u>	Negligently fails or is unable to provide necessary
9		sustenance for each pet animal; and
10	<u>(c)</u>	Displays an inability to recognize or understand the
11		nature of, or has reckless disregard for, the
12		conditions under which the pet animals are living and
13		the deleterious impact the conditions have on the pet
14		animals' and owner's health and well-being.
15	(2)	Animal hoarding is a misdemeanor."

- 1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 3 begun, before its effective date.
- 4 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
