A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIMES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 711, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§711- Human consumption of a cat or dog. (1) A person
- 5 commits the offense of human consumption of a cat or dog if,
- 6 unless otherwise authorized by law, the person intentionally or
- 7 knowingly consumes a cat or dog.
- 8 (2) Nothing in this section is intended to affect any
- 9 civil remedies available for a violation of this section.
- 10 (3) Human consumption of a cat or dog is a class C
- 11 felony."
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 711-1100, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended by amending the definition of "pet animal" to read as
- 14 follows:
- ""Pet animal" means a dog, cat, domesticated rabbit, guinea
- 16 pig, domesticated pig, horse, or caged [birds] bird
- 17 (passeriformes, piciformes, and psittaciformes only) so long as



- 1 the domesticated rabbit, guinea pig, domesticated pig, or caged
- 2 bird is not bred for consumption.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun, before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
