A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to authorize the
- Hawaii public housing authority to include in a request for
- 3 proposals for the construction or renovation of a public housing
- 4 project a price preference or scoring bonus to an offeror who
- 5 proposes to redevelop concurrently an adjacent site.
- 6 SECTION 2. Chapter 356D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 7 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
- 8 designated and to read as follows:
- 9 *§356D- Price preference or scoring bonus to offeror who
- 10 proposes to redevelop adjacent real property concurrently with
- 11 construction or renovation of a federal or state low-income
- 12 housing project. (a) The authority may include in a request
- 13 for proposals for the construction or renovation of a federal or
- 14 state low-income housing project under this chapter, a price
- preference or scoring bonus, to an offeror who has redeveloped 15
- 16 or proposes to redevelop, concurrently with the proposed
- 17 construction or renovation work, an offeror-controlled adjacent

1	site to m	ake available new or renovated dwelling units for low-
2	income ho	ouseholds. For the purposes of this section, "offeror-
3	controlle	ed adjacent site" means real property that is adjacent
4	to the bo	undaries of the subject federal or state low-income
5	housing p	roject and either owned in fee simple by the offeror or
6	<u>leased</u> to	the offeror for a period of at least thirty years.
7	<u>(b)</u>	A request for proposals issued pursuant to this
8	section shall expressly state that:	
9	(1)	An offeror may include a plan to redevelop
10		concurrently an adjacent site, or cite as a public
11		benefit the completed or ongoing redevelopment of
12		dwelling units for low-income households on an
13		offeror-controlled adjacent site; and
14	(2)	An offeror shall not be disqualified solely on the
15		basis that the offeror's proposal did not include an
16		option to redevelop an adjacent site.
17	<u>(c)</u>	If providing a price preference, the request for
18	proposals	shall identify the percentage of preference, which may
19	vary acco	rding to the following in relation to the adjacent
20	<u>site:</u>	
21	(1)	The extent and type of the proposed completed or
22		ongoing redevelopment activity;

1	(2) The tenure of the offeror; and		
2	(3) The number of dwelling units proposed to be or		
3	actually made available to low-income households.		
4	(d) If providing a scoring bonus, the request for		
5	proposals shall clearly describe said scoring bonus and shall		
6	include but not be limited to descriptions of:		
7	(1) The criteria for evaluating the proposed, completed,		
8	or ongoing redevelopment activity; and		
9	(2) The relative importance of the redevelopment criterion		
10	in comparison to other criteria."		
11	SECTION 3. Section 356D-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
12	amended to read as follows:		
13	"[+]§356D-17[+] Public works contracts. The authority may		
14	make, execute, and carry out contracts for, or in connection		
15	with, any public housing project in the manner provided in		
16	chapter 103D [and], section 103-53[; and with], and section		
17	356D With regard to [the] said contracts, the term		
18	"procurement officer", as used in chapter 103D, shall mean the		
19	authority or officer authorized by the authority to act as its		
20	contracting officer. Unless made and executed in the name of		
21	the State, each contract made and executed as authorized in this		
22	section shall state therein that it is so made and executed."
