A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TOURISM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 201B-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 2 The authority shall be headed by a policy-making 3 board of directors [which] that consists of twelve public, 4 5 voting members, and four ex officio nonvoting members; provided 6 that: 7 Twelve public, voting members shall be appointed by (1)the governor as provided in section 26-34, except as otherwise provided by law; 9 The twelve public, voting members shall be composed of 10 (2)11 at least one representative each from the city and 12 county of Honolulu and the counties of Hawaii, Kauai, 13 and Maui[+], respectively; the remaining public 14 members shall be appointed at-large; 15 Of the twelve public, voting members, three shall be (3) 16 appointed by the governor from a list of three names

submitted for each appointment by the president of the

1		senate, and three shall be appointed by the governor
2		from a list of three names submitted for each
3		appointment by the speaker of the house of
4		representatives; provided that if fewer than three
5		names are submitted for each appointment, the governor
6		may disregard the list;
7	(4)	At least six of the twelve public, voting members

- shall have knowledge, experience, and expertise in the area of visitor industry management, marketing, promotion, transportation, retail, entertainment, or visitor attractions, and at least one shall have knowledge, experience, and expertise in the area of Hawaiian cultural practices; provided that no more than three members shall represent, be employed by, or be under contract to any sector of the industry represented on the board;
- (5) The governor shall make appointments to ensure the fulfillment of all requirements; provided that any appointments made after July 1, 2002, shall be made to fulfill the requirements in place when the appointments are made;

4	(7)	The director of transportation, or a designated
5		representative, shall be an ex officio nonvoting

11		culture and the arts, or a designated representative,
12		shall be an ex officio nonvoting member."
