## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS TO ASSIST SOPOGY INC., IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF RENEWABLE ENERGY.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the development of
- 2 clean electricity from a renewable and abundant resource, the
- 3 sun, at a price lower than the market price and independent from
- 4 oil price fluctuations is in the best interests of the public.
- 5 Sopogy Inc., specializes in the development, manufacture, and
- 6 distribution of its proprietary concentrated solar power systems
- 7 that generate electricity. The legislature finds that the
- 8 construction of a solar farm power plant that Sopogy Inc., seeks
- 9 to create at the natural energy laboratory of Hawaii authority
- 10 on the island of Hawaii, would demonstrate how electricity could
- 11 be produced by using solar power systems.
- 12 For the foregoing reasons, the legislature finds and
- 13 declares that the issuance of special purpose revenue bonds
- 14 under this Act is in the public interest and is beneficial to
- 15 the public health, safety, and general welfare.
- 16 The legislature further finds that part V, chapter 39A,
- 17 Hawaii Revised Statutes, permits the State to financially assist

- 1 industrial enterprises through the issuance of special purpose
- 2 revenue bonds and that the issuance of special purpose revenue
- 3 bonds under this Act is in the public interest and for the
- 4 public health, safety, and general welfare of the state. The
- 5 legislature finds that Sopogy Inc., is an industrial enterprise
- 6 meeting the qualifications for special purpose revenue bond
- 7 assistance under part V, chapter 39A, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 8 The special purpose revenue bonds authorized under this Act will
- 9 provide low interest rate bond financing for the construction of
- 10 a solar farm power plant at the natural energy laboratory of
- 11 Hawaii authority.
- 12 SECTION 2. Pursuant to part V, chapter 39A, Hawaii Revised
- 13 Statutes, the department of budget and finance, with the
- 14 approval of the governor, is authorized to issue special purpose
- 15 revenue bonds in a total amount not to exceed \$10,000,000 in one
- 16 or more series, for the purpose of assisting Sopogy Inc., with
- 17 the planning, designing, construction, equipping, and operating
- 18 Sopogy Inc.'s solar farm power plant at the natural energy
- 19 laboratory of Hawaii authority.
- The legislature hereby finds and determines that the
- 21 activity and facilities of Sopogy Inc., constitute a project as



- 1 defined in part V, chapter 39A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and the
- 2 financing thereof is assistance to an industrial enterprise.
- 3 SECTION 3. The special purpose revenue bonds and the
- 4 refunding special purpose revenue bonds issued under this Act
- 5 shall be issued pursuant to part V, chapter 39A, Hawaii Revised
- 6 Statutes, relating to the power to issue special purpose revenue
- 7 bonds to assist industrial enterprises.
- 8 SECTION 4. The department of budget and finance is
- 9 authorized, from time to time, including times subsequent to
- 10 June 30, 2012, to issue special purpose revenue bonds in
- 11 whatever principal amounts the department shall determine to be
- 12 necessary to refund the special purpose revenue bonds authorized
- 13 in section 2 and any refunding of special purpose revenue bonds
- 14 authorized in this section, regardless of whether the
- 15 outstanding special purpose revenue bonds or refunding special
- 16 purpose revenue bonds have matured or are the subject of
- 17 redemption or whether the refunding special purpose revenue
- 18 bonds shall be bonds for the multi-project programs described in
- 19 section 2. In making this determination, the department shall
- 20 comply with federal law relating to the exemption from federal
- 21 income taxation of the interest on bonds of the nature
- 22 authorized by this section.

- 1 SECTION 5. The authorization to issue special purpose
- 2 revenue bonds under this Act shall lapse on June 30, 2012.
- 3 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
