### A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE X, SECTION 2, OF THE HAWAII CONSTITUTION, REGARDING THE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the elections of the
- 2 members of the board of education consistently have been
- 3 accompanied by a large percentage of blank ballots, which may be
- 4 an indication that the electorate often does not have enough
- 5 information about the candidates. A major factor in this
- 6 situation is that all Oahu voters elect board members for the
- 7 island, even when the candidate is running to represent a school
- 8 district other than the voter's district. This situation is
- 9 even more pronounced with the neighbor islands, with the
- 10 electorate on Kauai voting for the island of Hawaii member, and
- 11 vice versa. Name recognition and knowledge of the
- 12 qualifications of the candidates would be greatly increased if
- 13 the candidates need campaign only within a limited local
- 14 district.
- 15 The legislature further finds that the current voting
- 16 districts of the board of education also make it difficult for
- 17 elected members to be responsive to the issues and concerns of

- 1 communities and schools within departmental districts that they
- 2 represent; for example, the windward district member on issues
- 3 in the leeward district or the Kauai district member on issues
- 4 for Molokai, which is part of the Maui district. In addition,
- 5 members elected from Oahu cannot effectively represent all of
- 6 Oahu, nor can the neighbor island members represent all of the
- 7 neighbor islands.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to propose an amendment to
- 9 Article X, section 2, of the Constitution of the State of Hawaii
- 10 to require that:
- 11 (1) The board of education shall be composed of seventeen
- 12 voting members elected in a nonpartisan manner by the
- 13 qualified voters of the respective school board
- districts, as provided by law; and
- 15 (2) School board districts shall be designated by each
- scheduled reapportionment commission.
- 17 SECTION 2. Article 10, section 2, of the Constitution of
- 18 the State of Hawaii is amended to read as follows:
- 19 "BOARD OF EDUCATION
- 20 Section 2. There shall be a board of education composed of
- 21 seventeen voting members who shall be elected in a nonpartisan
- 22 manner by the qualified voters[, as provided by law, from two

1 at large school board districts. The first school board 2 district shall be comprised of the island of Oahu and all other 3 islands not specifically enumerated. The second school board 4 district shall be comprised of the islands of Hawaii, Maui, 5 Lanai, Molokai, Kahoolawe, Kauai and Niihau. Each at large 6 school board district shall be divided into departmental school 7 districts, as may be provided by law. There shall be at least 8 one member residing in each departmental school district.] of 9 the respective school board districts, as provided by law. 10 School board districts shall be designated by each scheduled 11 reapportionment commission. The Hawaii State Student Council 12 shall select a public high school student to serve as a 13 nonvoting member on the board of education." 14 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall be as follows: 15 16 "Shall the board of education be composed of seventeen 17 voting members who represent a board district comprised of 18 three representative districts and elected in a nonpartisan 19 manner by the qualified voters of the respective school 20 board districts, as provided by law?"

5	compliance with article XVII, section 3, of the Constitution of
6	the State of Hawaii, and shall apply to the general election of

9	existence on the day before ratification shall remain in force
10	and effect until a duly constituted reapportionment commission
