## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO UNFAIR AND DECEPTIVE TRADE PRACTICES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 480, part I, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 2 is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "S480- Tampering with for-profit entertainment games.
- 5 A person engages in an unfair or deceptive act or practice
- 6 within the meaning of section 480-2 when, in the conduct of any
- 7 trade or commerce, the person tampers with for-profit
- 8 entertainment games, including coin- or dollar bill-operated
- 9 machines and arcade games. As used in this section, "tampering
- 10 with for-profit entertainment games" means the person knowingly
- 11 conducts, carries on, operates, or exposes for play, or allows
- 12 to be conducted, carried on, operated, or exposed for play, any
- 13 for-profit entertainment game that has been marked, tampered
- 14 with, or otherwise placed in a condition, or operated in a
- 15 manner the result of which tends to deceive the public or tends
- 16 to alter the normal selection of criteria that determine the
- 17 result of a game."
