A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WITNESSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Section 621-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 Every witness legally required to attend a state court or grand jury in any criminal case, other than a public 4 officer or employee, shall be entitled to [\$20] \$55 for each 5 day's attendance and a reasonable mileage fee to be established 6 7 pursuant to rules adopted by the judiciary for each mile 8 actually and necessarily traveled on the ground each way, 9 including travel to and from the nearest airport when required to travel from another island or from outside the State. 10 11 addition to witness' fees, every witness $[\tau]$ who attends a state 12 court from outside the State shall be entitled to the actual 13 round-trip cost of plane travel, plus [\$110 per twenty-four-hour 14 day, \$160 for each day's attendance, or if from any island 15 other than that on which the court holds session, shall be entitled to the actual round-trip cost of plane travel, plus \$55 16

[per twenty-four-hour day,] for each day's attendance, except

- 1 that if the witness is required to stay overnight, the witness
- 2 shall be entitled to an additional \$160 for each day's
- 3 attendance, which amounts shall cover all personal expenses,
- 4 such as board and lodging. [These per diem payments shall be
- 5 computed on the basis of quarter day periods of time.] "
- 6 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so much
- 8 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and the
- 9 same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 10 2008-2009, to carry out the purposes of this Act. The sums
- 11 appropriated shall be expended by the department of budget and
- 12 finance.
- 13 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
