## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that students from
2	military families, other countries and cultures, and across the
3	State or even the district face unique academic and cultural
4	issues when transitioning from their former schools to public
5	schools in the State. If not addressed, these issues may
6	negatively impact the academic potential of these students and
7	lead to other problems as well. Fortunately, a model transition
8	program at Radford high school has gained deserved recognition
9	for successfully assisting students from military families,
10	other countries and cultures, and across the State or the
11	district with the transitions to schools in the State.
12	The purpose of this Act is to expand the concept of the
13	Radford high school transition program to all other schools in
14	the department of education.
15	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
16	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$3,000,000, or so

much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and the same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
