RELATING TO VETERANS LICENSE PLATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 249-9.2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended to read as follows: "§249-9.2 Special number plates; military service. 3 (a) 4 In lieu of the number plates contracted on behalf of the counties by the director of finance of the city and county of 5 Honolulu, the director of finance shall provide [for a fee,] one 6 set of special number plates upon the receipt of an application 7 8 together with: 9 Specific proof that the applicant was awarded the (1)10 Purple Heart by the United States Department of 11 Defense for wounds received in military or naval 12 combat against an armed enemy of the United States; Certification that the applicant is a veteran; 13 (2) 14 Specific proof that the applicant was serving the (3) United States in the military or as a civilian, on 15

Oahu, or offshore at a distance of not more than three
