### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PROCUREMENT CODE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§103D- Hawaii agricultural products. (a) To encourage
- 5 the purchase and use of Hawaii agricultural products in the food
- 6 operations of state correctional facilities and state hospitals
- 7 and healthcare facilities, contracts shall be awarded to the
- 8 lowest responsible and responsive bidders, with preference given
- 9 to the agricultural products raised or grown in Hawaii.
- (b) The policy board shall adopt rules in accordance with
- 11 chapter 91 governing preference for Hawaii agricultural
- 12 products. The rules shall establish percentages of preference
- 13 and the method of determining the qualifications of various
- 14 agricultural products for preference.
- 15 (c) The state procurement office, with the assistance of
- 16 the department of agriculture, shall develop a Hawaii
- 17 agricultural product program that shall require the state
