## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OLD GOVERNMENT ROADS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 264-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$264-2 Owned by government[+]; old government roads. (a)
- 4 The ownership of all public highways and the land, real estate
- 5 and property of the same shall be in the government in fee
- 6 simple. The term "government" as used herein means the State
- 7 with reference to state highways and means the respective
- 8 counties with reference to county highways. If any county
- 9 highway is required by the State for state highway purposes, the
- 10 ownership of the county highway shall be transferred to and
- 11 vested in the State without compensation.
- 12 The governor may, at any time by executive order, turn over
- 13 to any county, state land, in fee simple, for use as a county
- 14 highway, and the county involved shall thereafter be responsible
- 15 for its repair and maintenance as a county highway.

- 1 The ownership of all county highways is transferred to and
- 2 vested in the respective counties in which the county highways
- 3 lie.
- 4 (b) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the ownership
- 5 of old government roads, as provided in Act 47 of Session Laws
- 6 of Hawaii 1892, as amended, is declared to be jointly owned by
- 7 the State and the respective county in which the government road
- 8 is located; provided that an old government road shall be open
- 9 for use by the public; and provided further that no person shall
- 10 block access through an old government road."
- 11 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
