A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LIABILITY OF STATE AND COUNTY GOVERNMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the limitations on 2 state and county liability have proven to be beneficial to the 3 state and county governments, as well as the public. 4 liability protections have reduced the exposure of the state and 5 county governments to substantial damages and, as a result, have allowed the state and county governments to keep recreational 6 7 areas on public lands and public beach parks with potentially 8 dangerous conditions open to the public. The legislature 9 further finds that state and county compliance with the statutorily required public warning of dangerous conditions on 10 certain public lands has contributed to an improvement in public 11 safety in these areas, which justifies making the current 12 13 liability exemptions for state and county governments relating 14 to public land and actions of county lifeguards permanent. 15 The purpose of this Act is to provide state and county 16 governments with liability protection for public use of certain public lands and public beach parks. The Act also provides 17 18 state and county governments with a permanent exception from
