## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DISASTER RELIEF.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Act 118, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006, is amended by amending section 26 to read as follows:

  "SECTION 26. Any provision of this Act to the contrary notwithstanding, the appropriations authorized under this Act shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year for which the
- 6 appropriations were made. All unexpended and unencumbered
- 7 balances of the appropriations made in this Act as of the close
- **8** of business on June 30, [2007,] 2009, shall lapse."
- 9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for
- 12 emergency supply caches to support disaster victims and
- 13 communities that may become isolated due to natural disasters.
- 14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 15 defense for the purposes of this section.
- 16 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so

- 1 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for
- 2 the state civil defense major disaster fund established pursuant
- 3 to section 127-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 4 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 5 defense for the purposes of this section.
- 6 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 8 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for
- 9 the state civil defense emergency supply program to effectively
- 10 equip emergency shelters in order to support special needs
- 11 populations and to maintain the development of the emergency
- 12 supply program.
- 13 The sum appropriated by this section shall be expended by
- 14 the department of defense for the purposes of this section.
- 15 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
