A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PESTICIDES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 149A-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted 3 and to read as follows: ""Structural pest control applicator" means a commercial 4 5 pesticide applicator that possesses a valid license for pest control under chapter 460J." 6 SECTION 2. Section 149A-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 7 8 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: "(b) It shall be unlawful to: 9 10 Detach, alter, deface, or destroy, in whole or in (1)11 part, any label or alter any labeling of a pesticide 12 unless it is approved by the department to correct an 13 improper label or labeling under section 24(c), 14 FIFRA[+]; 15 (2) Add any substance to, or take any substance from, a 16 pesticide in a manner that may defeat the purpose of 17 this chapter [-];
