A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the board of
- 2 education is faced with increasingly complex legal issues and
- 3 matters that require expedited attention and response. Having
- 4 the flexibility to hire independent legal counsel will expedite
- 5 the disposition of legal issues and cases related to the board
- 6 of education's purview, as well as the public schools and
- 7 libraries.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to give the board of education
- 9 the authority to employ or retain its own legal counsel.
- 10 SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 12 and to read as follows:
- 13 "§302A- Board attorneys. (a) The board may employ or
- 14 retain by contract one or more attorneys who are independent of
- the department of the attorney general, to provide legal
- 16 services to the board, including:
