A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMUNITY-BASED ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the business

2 community, nonprofit community, and other entrepreneurs require

3 a functional, service-oriented agency that is readily accessible

4 to provide business counseling, financial backing, and general

5 support to faster real community-based economic development of

6 the various products and services demonstrating and embracing

7 Hawaii's diversified economy.

8 The Hawaii community-based economic development technical

9 and financial assistance program of the department of business,

economic development, and tourism was established for this very

11 purpose. The legislature has authorized the Hawaii community-

12 based economic development technical and financial assistance

13 program to provide needed financial assistance to community-

based entrepreneurs through low interest loans and grants to

The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for the 1 Hawaii community-based economic development technical and 2 financial assistance program. 3 4 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$500,000, or so much 5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and the 6 same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009, to the community-based economic development revolving 8 fund created in section 210D-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes. 9 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the community-10 based economic development revolving fund the sum of \$500,000, 11 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-12 2008, and the same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary 13 for fiscal year 2008-2009, to provide grants under the Hawaii 14 community-based economic development technical and financial 15 16 assistance program.
