## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CORRECTIONS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Approximately ten Hawaii residents are housed 2 in various prisons in the continental United States under the 3 Interstate Corrections Compact. Currently, there is no monitoring of conditions at these prisons or of the health and 4 5 safety of the Hawaii inmates held in those prisons. 6 The purposes of this Act are to: Require the mainland branch of the corrections 7 (1)division of the department of public safety to monitor 8 and report on the conditions of Hawaii residents held 9 in mainland prisons under the Interstate Corrections 10 11 Compact; and Make an appropriation to allow the mainland branch to 12 (2) monitor and report on the conditions of these Hawaii inmates.
- 13 14 15 SECTION 2. The mainland branch of the corrections division
- 16 of the department of public safety is directed, during its quarterly trips to the mainland, to monitor Hawaii inmates being 17

- 1 housed under contracts in various private mainland prisons, to
- 2 include the monitoring of Hawaii residents being imprisoned in
- 3 any mainland prison under the Interstate Corrections Compact.
- 4 The monitor reports of these latter inmates and of inmates at
- 5 the other contracted private prisons shall be minimally redacted
- 6 to exclude a particular prisoner's name and other sensitive and
- 7 protected information. All monitor reports shall comply with
- 8 and be available for public inspection pursuant to chapter 92F,
- 9 Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 10 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ , or so much
- 12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and the
- 13 same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 14 2008-2009, for the purpose of allowing the mainland branch of
- 15 the corrections division of the department of public safety to
- 16 monitor and report on Hawaii inmates held in mainland prisons
- 17 under the Interstate Corrections Compact.
- 18 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 19 of public safety for the purposes of this Act.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
