A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAIIAN LANGUAGE COLLEGE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The Hawaiian language college at the University
- 2 of Hawaii has had several important achievements since the
- 3 legislative mandate for its establishment ten years ago. The
- 4 legislature finds that funding for its programs and faculty have
- 5 not been consistent with the achievements and activities of the
- 6 college.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to fund the Hawaiian language
- 8 college at the University of Hawaii so it can continue its
- 9 contributions, leadership, and achievements in the area of
- 10 indigenous language teaching and revitalization.
- 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
- 13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, for
- 14 the Hawaiian language college at the University of Hawaii.
- 15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 16 education for the purposes of this Act.

1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
